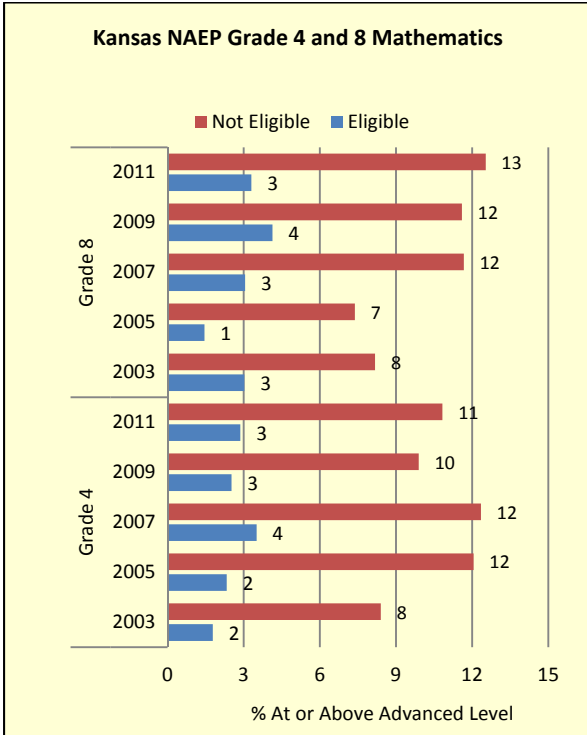
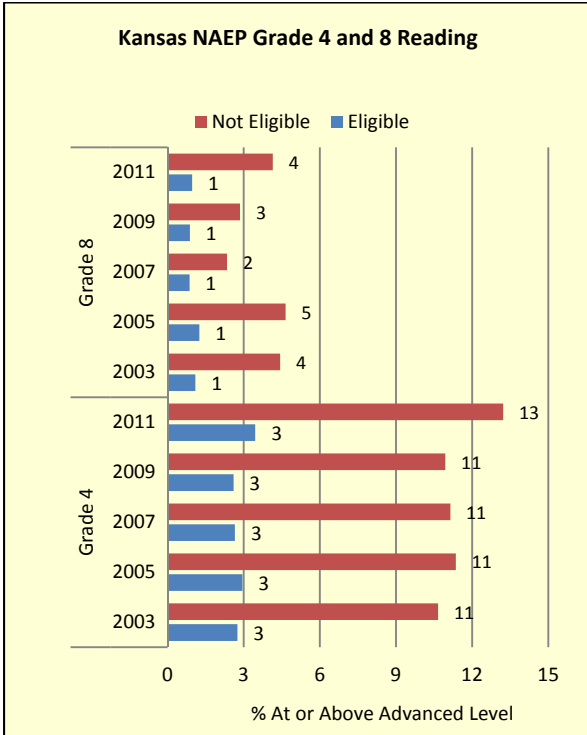
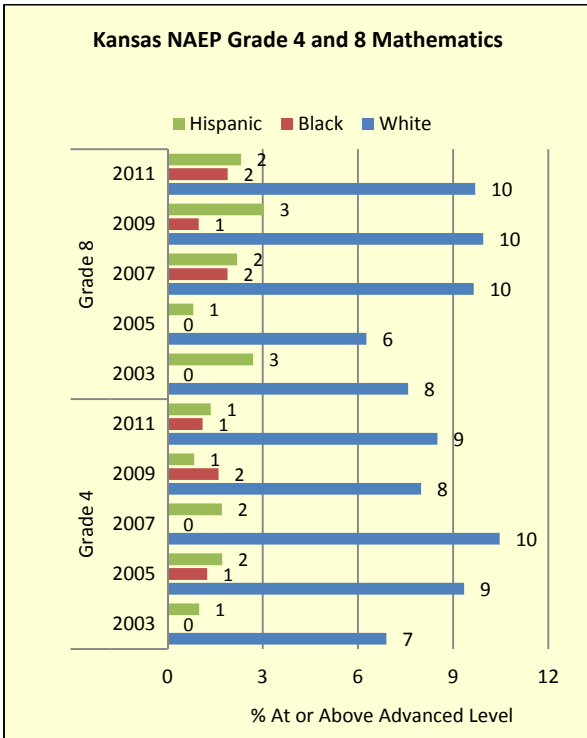
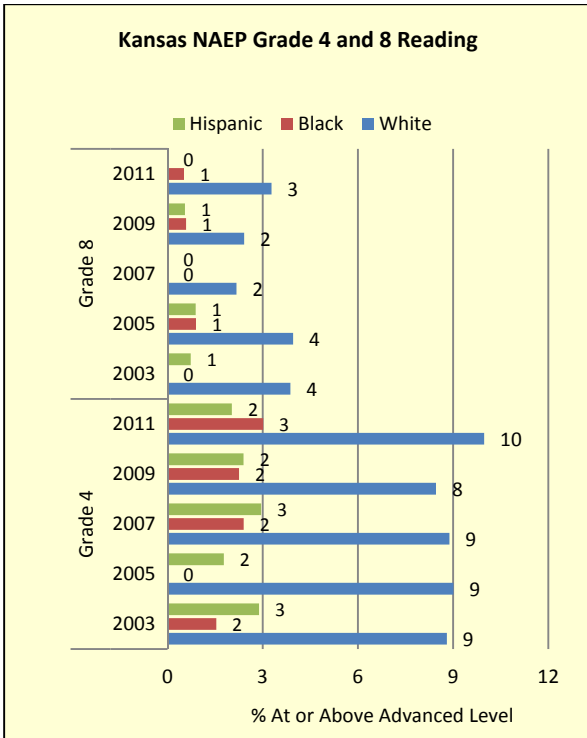
NAEP testing data as well as state assessment results reveal substantial excellence gaps for Black, Hispanic, and Free and Reduced Lunch Eligible (FARM) students.

According to NAEP proficiency data, since 2003 the excellence gaps in both Grade 4 and Grade 8 Math have increased between White and Black students as well as White and Hispanic students. The gap since 2003 between the same student groups in Reading is only slightly smaller. The difference between scores at the above average level between White and Black students in Grade 8 Math has remained significant and unchanged since 2003.

Between FARM and non-FARM students, the gaps in above average Grade 4 and Grade 8 Math students have widened significantly since 2003. Similarly, the gap in Grade 8 Reading has also widened, largely due to the increase in non-FARM students scoring above average. The difference in scores at the above average level between FARM and non-FARM students in Math has doubled since 2003.

In contrast to the NAEP assessment, the Kansas assessment scores considerably more students at the advanced level. For instance, in 2011 35% of White Grade 4 Math students scored above average on the Kansas assessment while NAEP scored 10% of students at that level. Still, the Kansas assessment reveals significant Excellence Gaps. In 2011, these gaps were widest between White and Black students in Grade 8 Reading and White and Black students in Grade 4 Math.
